A: We provide highly detailed cleaning for residential and commercial properties, and we use all non-toxic products. We also supply everything required for the cleaning unless the client would like something specific used. We bring clean sponges, mop heads, microfibers, towels and more. We also use the top-of-the-line Miele Hepa filter canister vacuum. On average, for residential, a regular green cleaning runs between two and three hours. 
